TDI209/21 CLERK'S UPDATE ON MATTERS RAISED PREVIOUSLY

The Clerk reported verbally that correspondence was outstanding in relation to: the railings running down the cliff path from the Pavilion undercroft and the playing field at Larpool Lane, where more information had been requested on the replacement of the football goal and the process of identifying additional cemetery land. Requests had been made to Scarborough Borough Council. Substantive responses were awaited. Any progress to be reported to a future meeting.

TDI210/21 MATTERS OF REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE REQUIRED IN TOWN

This item gives members an opportunity to highlight areas of concern which may be advanced or brought to the attention of the appropriate department at either the borough or county council.

- 1. (TDI120/20) The drainage pipe to the promenade east of Upgang Ravine,** which had been reported as programmed for repair is still exposed.
