Henry saw action in many of the main battles of WW1. These included Gallipoli in which he was a survivor of the HMS Hythe disaster the Somme, Passchendale and Cambrai. Before the war Henry had a promising football career, but after been gassed at Passchendale, which affected his sight, he had to give up playing. After the war he became a referee and was one of the first refs to send off a goal keeper in a league game. He was a scout for Hull City and Yorkshire Cricket Club he died aged 65 from a heart attack.
